REACH Directive

Dear customer,

according to the REACH directive, our products are defined as „articles“ which do not fall under the compliance to be registered according to REACH.

As a producer of „articles“, according to REACH our company is a so called „downstream user“, and therefore also does not fall under the compliance to be registered according to REACH. An obligation for registration only exists for downstream users in case of direct imports of substances or preparations from outside the European Union. For our company, this is not the case.

Our suppliers have assured us that the substances contained in the products that we use, are already registered at the European Chemical Agency (ECHA)

According to REACH regulation, our self adhesive materials are free from “substances of very high concern for health” (SVHC) included in the ECHA list (art.59) in quantities exceeding 0,1% of weight (ECHA list updated 27th June 2018), except for the

which contain BPA (4,4'-isopropylidenediphenol bisphenol A) e

OPP TC WHITE GLOSS INKJET

OPP TC CLEAR GLOSS INKJET

which contain Boric Acid (CAS n° 10043-35-3)
